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Management Discussion of Fund Performance

November 13, 2018

This Management Discussion of Fund Performance presents the portfolio management team's view on the significant factors and developments during the period ended September 30, 2018, that have affected the Fund's performance and outlook. If the Fund was established during the period, "period" represents the period from inception to the end of the fiscal period. For information on the Fund's longer-term performance, as applicable, please refer to the *Past Performance* section of the report. In this report, "Mackenzie" refers to Mackenzie Financial Corporation, the manager of the Fund. In addition, net asset value ("NAV") refers to the value of the Fund as calculated for transaction purposes, on which the discussion of Fund performance is based.

Results of Operations

Investment Performance

The performance of the Fund's Series A securities is discussed below. The performance of all series is shown in the *Past Performance* section of the report. Where series returns differ, it is primarily because different levels of fees and expenses were charged to each series, or because securities of a series were not issued and outstanding for the entire reporting period. Please refer to the *Fund Formation and Series Information* section of this report for the varying management and administration fees payable by each series.

During the period, the Fund's Series A securities returned 10.6% (after deducting fees and expenses paid by the series). This compares with the S&P 500 Index return of 11.8%. All index and series returns are calculated on a total return basis in Canadian dollar terms. Investors cannot invest in the index without incurring fees, expenses and commissions, which are not reflected in the index returns.

U.S. equity markets rose over the period, driven in part by strong corporate earnings. Markets reached record highs despite higher bond yields and increased trade tensions with several key trading partners. The U.S. dollar appreciated relative to the Canadian dollar. The U.S. Federal Reserve raised the federal funds rate in June and September, and suggested that gradual rate increases were likely to continue through 2019.

Within the S&P 500 Index, health care, consumer discretionary and information technology were the strongest sectors in Canadian dollar terms, while financials, materials and consumer staples were the weakest.

The Fund invested all its assets in Mackenzie Maximum Diversification US Index ETF (the "Underlying ETF"), which tracks the TOBAM Maximum Diversification USA Index. The Underlying ETF's core investment philosophy is to seek enhanced diversification through a balanced exposure to all relevant risk factors in the U.S. equity market. As a result of this approach, the Fund may have less concentrated risk exposures than those of a market capitalization weighted index, such as the S&P 500 Index.

The Fund underperformed the S&P 500 Index primarily because of the Underlying ETF's overweight position and stock selection in the consumer staples sector. An underweight position in the information technology sector and stock selection in the materials sector also detracted from performance.

Conversely, underweight exposure to the financials sector and overweight exposure to the consumer discretionary sector contributed to performance.

The Fund's foreign currency exposure was not hedged. Currency exposure had a small positive impact on the performance of both the Fund and the index as the U.S. dollar appreciated slightly relative to the Canadian dollar.

Over the period, changes were made to the Underlying ETF's holdings to reflect changes in the composition of the TOBAM Maximum Diversification USA Index. Exposure to the consumer discretionary and utilities sectors increased, while exposure to the information technology, consumer staples and materials sectors decreased.

Net Assets

The Fund's NAV increased by 496.5% to \$63.5 million at September 30, 2018, from \$10.6 million at March 31, 2018. This change was composed primarily of \$2.1 million in net income (including dividend and interest income) from investment performance, after deducting fees and expenses, and \$50.8 million in net sales (which includes an inflow of \$50.6 million relating to fund merger activity).

Fees and Expenses

The annualized management expense ratio ("MER") for Series A of 2.00% during the period ended September 30, 2018, was lower than the MER of 2.05% for the year ended March 31, 2018. The MERs (before and after waivers or absorptions, if any) for each series are presented in the *Financial Highlights* section of this report. The MERs for Series A and Series FB decreased due to a decrease in fund costs. The MERs for Series F, Series F5, Series PW, Series PWFB, Series PWFB5 and Series PWT5 decreased due to a decrease in fund costs and a decrease in the management fee rates effective June 1, 2018, as noted in the *Fund Formation and Series Information* section of the report.



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Recent Developments

The portfolio management team of the Underlying ETF uses a quantitative model to determine the combination of equities that will produce an equity portfolio with the highest diversification ratio. As such, the team does not generate market expectations nor move the portfolio according to any forecast.

Effective June 1, 2018, Series PWF securities were consolidated into Series F securities, and Series PWF5 securities were consolidated into Series F5 securities.

Following the approval of investors in Mackenzie US Low Volatility Fund and the securities regulators, Mackenzie US Low Volatility Fund merged into the Fund on July 6, 2018. Mackenzie does not consider this merger to be a material change from the Fund's perspective.

Related Party Transactions

The following arrangements result in fees paid by the Fund to Mackenzie or to companies affiliated with the Fund.

Management and Administration Services

For each applicable series, the Fund paid management fees and administration fees to Mackenzie at the annual rates specified under *Fund Formation and Series Information* in this report and as more fully described in the Prospectus. In return for the administration fees, Mackenzie pays all costs and expenses (other than certain specified fund costs) required to operate the Fund that are not included in management fees. See also *Management Fees*.

Other Related Party Transactions

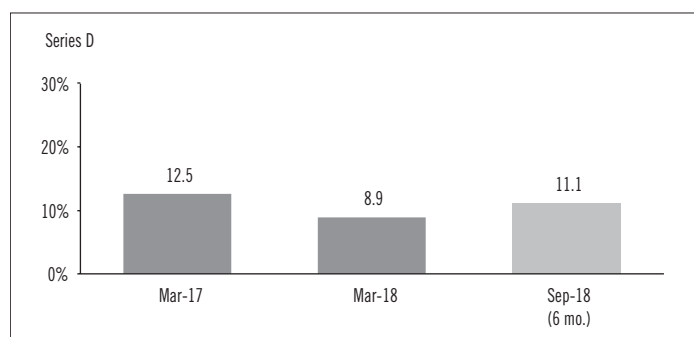
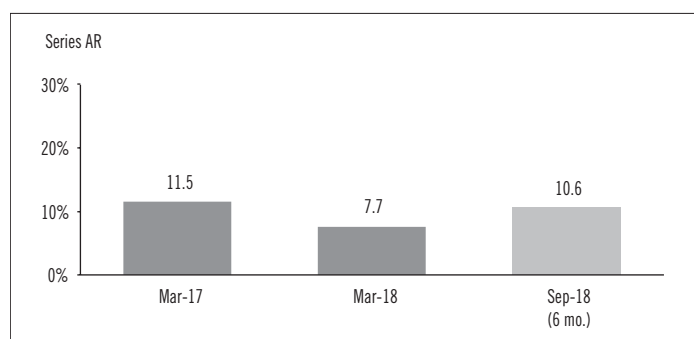
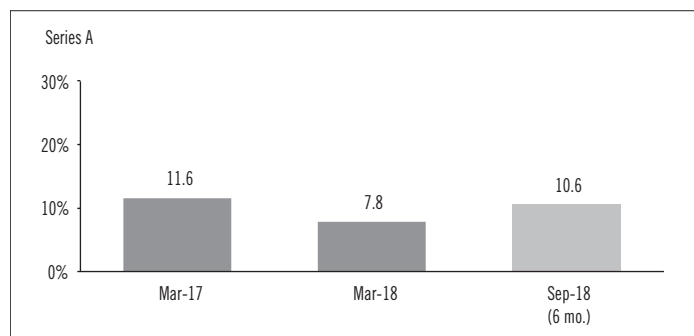
Investment funds managed by Mackenzie invest in Series R securities of the Fund on a prospectus-exempt basis in accordance with the investment objectives of those funds. At September 30, 2018, funds managed by Mackenzie owned 0.7% of the Fund's NAV. All related party transactions are based on the NAV per security on each transaction day.

At September 30, 2018, Mackenzie had an investment of \$26,433 in the Fund (less than 0.1% of the Fund's NAV).

Mackenzie relied on a recommendation issued by the Mackenzie Funds' Independent Review Committee to proceed with the merger of Mackenzie US Low Volatility Fund into the Fund in July 2018.

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Management Fees

The management fee for each applicable series is calculated and accrued daily as a percentage of its NAV. The Fund's management fees were used by Mackenzie to pay for the costs of managing the investment portfolio of the Fund and/or the underlying fund(s), as applicable, including providing investment analysis and recommendations, making investment decisions, making brokerage arrangements for the purchase and sale of the investment portfolio, and providing other services. Mackenzie also used the management fees to fund sales commissions, trailing commissions and any other compensation (collectively "distribution-related payments") to registered dealers and brokers whose clients invest in the Fund.

The following dealers affiliated with Mackenzie may be entitled to distribution-related payments from Mackenzie on the same basis as unrelated registered brokers and dealers: IPC Securities Corporation, Investors Group Securities Inc., IPC Investment Corporation and Investors Group Financial Services Inc.

Mackenzie used approximately 43% of the total management fee revenues received from all Mackenzie funds during the period to fund distribution-related payments to registered dealers and brokers. In comparison, such distribution-related payments for the Fund represented on average 49% of the management fees paid by all applicable series of the Fund during the period. The actual percentage for each series may be higher or lower than the average depending on the level of trailing commissions and sales commissions paid for that series. The higher proportion of distribution-related payments is primarily attributable to sales commissions related to gross sales of redemption charge securities of the Fund.



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Fund Formation and Series Information

The Fund may have undergone a number of changes, such as a reorganization or a change in manager, mandate or name. A history of the major changes affecting the Fund in the last 10 years can be found in the Fund's Annual Information Form.

Date of Formation June 13, 2016

The Fund may issue an unlimited number of securities of each series. The number of issued and outstanding securities of each series is disclosed in *Financial Highlights*.

Series AR securities are offered to retail investors in a Registered Disability Savings Plan offered by Mackenzie.

Series D securities are offered to retail investors investing a minimum of \$500 through a discount brokerage or other account approved by Mackenzie.

Series F and Series F5 securities are offered to investors who are enrolled in a dealer-sponsored fee-for-service or wrap program, who are subject to an asset-based fee rather than commissions on each transaction and who invest at least \$500 (\$5,000 for Series F5); they are also available to employees of Mackenzie and its subsidiaries, and directors of Mackenzie. Investors in Series F5 securities also want to receive a regular monthly cash flow of 5% per year.

Series FB and Series FB5 securities are offered to retail investors investing a minimum of \$500. Investors are required to negotiate their advisor service fee, which cannot exceed 1.50%, with their financial advisor. Investors in Series FB5 securities also want to receive a monthly cash flow of 5% per year.

Series O securities are offered only to investors investing a minimum of \$500,000 who are enrolled in Mackenzie Portfolio Architecture Service or Open Architecture Service; certain institutional investors; and certain qualifying employees of Mackenzie and its subsidiaries.

Series PW and Series PWT5 securities are offered through our Private Wealth Solutions to certain high net worth investors who invest a minimum of \$100,000. Investors in Series PWT5 securities also want to receive a monthly cash flow of 5% per year.

Series PWFB and Series PWFB5 securities are offered through our Private Wealth Solutions to certain high net worth investors who invest a minimum of \$100,000. Investors are required to negotiate their advisor service fee, which cannot exceed 1.50%, with their financial advisor. Investors in Series PWFB5 securities also want to receive a monthly cash flow of 5% per year.

Series PWX and Series PWX5 securities are offered through our Private Wealth Solutions to certain high net worth investors who invest a minimum of \$100,000. Investors are required to negotiate their advisor service fee, which cannot exceed 1.50%, with their financial advisor. Investors in Series PWX5 securities also want to receive a monthly cash flow of 5% per year.

Series R securities are offered only to other affiliated funds and certain institutional investors in connection with fund-of-fund arrangements.

Series PWF and Series PWF5 securities are no longer available for sale. Effective June 1, 2018, Series PWF and Series PWF5 securities were consolidated into Series F and Series F5 securities, respectively.

An investor in the Fund may choose among different purchase options that are available under each series. These purchase options are a sales charge purchase option, a redemption charge purchase option and a low-load purchase option. The charges under the sales charge purchase option are negotiated by investors with their dealers. The charges under the redemption charge and low-load purchase options are paid to Mackenzie if an investor redeems securities of the Fund during specific periods. Not all purchase options are available under each series of the Fund, and the charges for each purchase option may vary among the different series.
